On this day, Saturday dated twenty eighth July two thousand and eighteen, located at Medan, we, the undersigned bellow:

Director of SEAMEO Regional Centre for QITEP in Mathematics, based on the Decree of General Secretary, Ministry of Education and Culture number: 7656/A.A3/KP/2017, dated 6 February 2017, hereby act and represent SEAMEO Regional Centre for QITEP in Mathematics, domiciled at Jalan Kaliurang Km. 6 Sambisari, Condongcatur, Depok, Sleman, Yogyakarta, hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY.

The FIRST PARTY and the SECOND PARTY jointly referred to as THE PARTIES.

THE PARTIES hereby agree to establish and hold a Memorandum of Understanding in accordance with the provisions set forth in the articles.

ARTICLE 1 PURPOSE

With due regard to the rules and regulations applicable to the both parties, the purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to assist each other in the development of mathematics teaching and learning and other matters deemed necessary, as well as to support each other in executing the duties of both parties.

ARTICLE 2 SCOPE

The scope of his Memorandum of Understanding are:

- 1. joint activities in mathematics teaching and learning;
- 2. joint activities in improving the services quality of mathematics teaching and leraning; and
- other relevant activities agreed by THE PARTIES.

ARTICLE 3 IMPLEMENTATION

Implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be followed by an Agreement Letter drawn up and agreed by **THE PARTIES**, and approved by the representatives who act on behalf of **THE PARTIES**.

ARTICLE 4 FINANCING

Cost for the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be borne by **THE PARTIES** in accordance with the agreement applied.

ARTICLE 5 RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

Rights and obligations shall be discussed by **THE PARTIES** in accordance with the consequences of the agreement based the form and type of activities to be conducted

ARTICLE 6 PERIOD OF TIME

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective for five (5) years, starting from the signing date as specified in the beginning of this Memorandum of Understanding, and can be extended and amended in accordance with the agreement of **THE PARTIES**.

ARTICLE 7 DISPUTE RESOLUTION

 Any dispute concerning on the implementation and interpretation of the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably by THE PARTIES through consultation and/or negotiation.

In any case the dispute cannot be settled amicably, the termination of the this Memorandum of Understanding may be done legally by written notification from the FIRST PARTY to the SECOND

PARTY or vice versa in less than 60 (sixty) days.

3. Any termination of this Memorandum of Understanding as referred to in section 2 (two) occurred, if approved by **THE PARTIES**, the ongoing programme(s) may be continued until complete.

ARTICLE 8 ADDENDUM

- Any matters happened beyond the authority of THE PARTIES or within force (majeure) the
 possibility of changing the place and time of duties shall be considered by THE PARTIES.
- 2. The force (majeure) includes:
 - a. natural disasters;
 - b. government actions in fiscal and monetary sectors; and
 - c. unsecure circumstances.
- Any matter have not been mentioned in this Memorandum of Understanding shall be further discussed by mutual consent of THE PARTIES.
- 4. This Memorandum of Understanding is done in duplicate of 2 (two), all texts are being equally authentic.
